Craig Hiddleston

He was the #2 ranked junior in U18s in BC and Tennis BC rated Craig as one of the top 10 players to come out of BC in the 1980s. Craig played NCAA Div 1 Tennis in the US where he played number one singles and number one doubles for the University of Texas at San Antonio in his senior year.
